Discover Košice - Getting to Košice

Košice, the capital of East Slovakia. Situated right at the heart of East Slovakia region, Košíce is the perfect starting point for trips all around. Getting to Košice is easy, as it has its own international airport, good rail connections direct from all Central European capitals, and it is connected up to the main European road and motorway networks. Once you are in the city, getting around the compact city centre is a piece of cake.

BY AIR

The international airport in Košice is just 6 kilometres south of the city centre. There are daily flight connections with the Slovak capital Bratislava. At present, Košice has regular international air connections with the likes of Prague or Vienna.


The airport Budapest Ferihegy is just three hours drive from Košíce, and there are regular shuttle bus transfers between Budapest – Košice airports five times a day. Reservations: www.cassoviaexpres.sk, +421 (0) 915 115 555.

Košice Airport has a non-stop general aviation service for private and commercial travellers. For more information about all flights, visit www.airportkosice.sk or call the non-stop passenger information line on +421 (0) 55 683 2100.

The airport is connected to the city centre and the main train and bus stations by public bus number 23 every hour. The bus journey to the city centre takes around 15 minutes. You can also use a taxi service to get to the centre (you can find contact information on page 62).

BY TRAIN

Train connections from Vienna, Bratislava and Prague will take you right to Košice city centre. The comfortable journey by EC/IC train from Prague takes 8 hours, while from Bratislava it is just under 5 hours. If you travel at night, you can use the couchette or sleeping cars, or take a motorail train. Košice is also linked by rail to Budapest, with two direct connections - morning and afternoon, with the journey taking around 3.5 hours. Kiev is another destination that the city has direct connections with. For more information go to www.slovakrail.sk or www.cp.sk or call the information line +421 (0) 18 188.



BY BUS

There are direct bus links from Košice to numerous European capitals, i.e. Paris, Rotterdam, Brussels, London, Frankfurt, Berlin, Munich, Zurich, Geneva, Rome, Florence, Venice, Prague and Vienna. There are several connections daily between Bratislava and Košice. For more information, visit www.eurobus.sk or www.cp.sk or call the information line +421 [0] 972 250 305.

BY CAR


By its position at the north-south crossroads between Poland and Hungary and the east-west route from Bratislava/Prague to Ukraine, the city of Košice is easily accessible from every direction. You can get to Košice from Bratislava along the **E50** international route, most of which is by motorway. From Budapest you can go by motorway or by the **E71/E79** expressway. All routes connect up to the city ring road, from which you can cut off to the city centre, where you will find easy parking. Parking boxes are marked on the streets or you can use one of the car parks. Parking in the centre is charged (for more information about parking, see page 63).

No matter when you come, we guarantee that your stay will be full of experiences.

ATMOSPHERE, ARCHITECTURE AND HIDDEN TREASURES

Košice is more than a main street full of fantastic monuments and attractions, which include one of the easternmost Gothic cathedrals in Europe and the largest in Slovakia, Dóm svätej Alžbety (St. Elisabeth Cathedral). There are two more cathedrals in the city: Greek-Catholic and Orthodox, together with temples of 11 different faiths. The special atmosphere is enhanced by the little streets, alleyways and courtyards of the historical buildings in the centre, which conceal many exciting treasures. The many amazing buildings include those of the Jewish congregation – what is now called the House of Art or the Synagogue on Puškinova street, with its walls bearing the words of the large Jewish congregation that once used to live here. You should not miss out also on a tour of the remnants of the medieval city fortifications – Executioner's Bastion, the Dolná brána (Lower gateway), the Bastion on Krmanova street and the reconstructed bulwark on Hradbová street. Other interesting sites include Jakab Palace, Hrnčiarska street

- Crafts Lane, Mikluš Prison, the treasures of Komenského street or a visit to the Monastery and church of the Dominican Order, where under the carpets in the Presbytery we can find the ancient Indian swastika religious symbols (cult symbol in the shape of an equilateral cross). You can get to know the city also by its details – take a look at some of the beautiful balconies of the noble homes and buildings, for instance. They all have unique facades or their own special story to tell. Artistic works are complemented by sculptures (for example, the sitting Sándor Márai on Zbrojnična street or the Marathoner statue on Námestie Maratónu mieru (Peace Marathon Square), plaques and commemorative notices on houses recalling renowned former locals and residents of the city, or simply praising their beauty. The Košice period of the Argentinean Recoleta – Rozália cemetery offers a walk among the other treasures of the "dead town" – amazing headstones of some of the city's admired personalities.

ATTRACTIONS

In terms of size, **Košice Zoo** in the Kavečany district is the third largest in Central Europe, with its pride and joy being the breeding of Przewalski horses. Feeding the animals is always very popular, as is watching the majestic brown bear, which gave birth to quintuplets and putting Košice Zoo into the Guinness Book of World Records. In the summer months the Zoo has a special programme called Night at the Zoo – at the seasonal scout camp in the children's Zoo. The largest botanical garden in Slovakia in terms of area is the **Botanical Gardens** on Mánesova street, which is home to over 4,000 species of plants. The temporary exhibitions of tropical butterflies, orchids and cactuses are truly inspirational. In the summer, the various events that you must see include a trip on the **Children's railway** in the Čermel' valley, which is drawn by the oldest operating steam locomotive in Central Europe called Katka, or visit the **Watchtower** on Hradová hill offering a fantastic panorama of Košice, or try the original cocktail **Košické zlato (Košice Gold)**.

Košice breaths culture and sport

The title of European Capital of Culture 2013 encourages a visit to at least one cultural event in Košice. In traditional spirit you will be welcomed to the State Theatre Košice or the State Philharmonic Košice, for instance, or there is the unorthodox project Košice 2013 at Kasárne/Kulturpark or Tabačka Kulturfabrik. Košice lives also for sport. Join the many hockey fans for the electrifying atmosphere of the STEEL ARENA, support the basketball teams at the Infinity Arena or run the oldest marathon in Europe and the second oldest in the world – the International Peace Marathon. At the water-ski zone on Jazera lake you can find one of just three water-ski tow areas in Slovakia, where an excellent atmosphere is always quaranteed.

HERITAGE AND CITY WALKS – How to explore the city

The compact historic city centre boasts many monuments that catch your attention immediately by their impressiveness, but there are also many hidden in the shadows that need to be sought out. There is something for everyone, though. History, legends, amazing stories and something of interest on every corner – that is Košice, a city with which you will be in love at first sight. Mr. Róbert Pollák, director of the East Slovak Museum in Košice, gives you some good tips by revealing his own favourite monuments in Košice.

"We all have our own favourite cities and places in them where they like to return. Because Košice is my birthplace – "the little city", as I usually refer to it with people who haven't been here yet, I have a lot of favourite places in the city. But my real favourite I guess is Hlavná ulica and the surroundings. Find time to have a relaxing morning sat in the park between the majestic House of Art and the Theatre, which always fascinate me. I usually imagine how a century ago throngs of "Košičans" would move along the bustling promenade and surely debate over whether the new millennium would bring good or bad to them and the city. Try comparing

their possible imaginings with your own knowledge and experiences. It will be educational for sure. I can easily recommend yet another interesting experience
– a piece of Turkey in Košice. From the theatre, passing through the street
Premonštrátska ulička near Levoča House you go on until the Executioner's
Bastion. It is not a mosque or minaret, but a true copy of the architecture from
the ancient Turkish city of Tekirdağ, and what's more unique is that it

houses also original parts of the dining room, adorned with Oriental ornamentation from the beginning of the 18th century and transported to Košice in 29 crates in 1906.

Stroll through the streets of Košice and enjoy the ever present beauty of the monuments. If you would like to know more, we have a few tips for you on how to recognise not just the facades, but also the history and legends. Set off on a walking or heritage tour or walk of the city.

GUIDED TOURS OF THE CITY

You can take a guided tour of the city any time you want. From the many tours on offer, we recommend four tours for you here, in particular. **Two of them take you to Košice's greatest treasures**. The first, a walking tour, covers monuments from the Must See category, while the second unveils other legends of Košice. For those interested in becoming more acquainted with the most interesting sites of worship, there is a **tour of the finest Košice sacral buildings**. Regarding the history of Košice, there is also a **thematic Jewish tour**. **You can book your tours in person at the Košice Visitor Centre** or by using the tourism portal www.visitkosice.eu, or a combination of the two. All the tours start from outside the Košice Visitor Centre at Hlavná 59.

HERITAGE TOURS OF KOŠICE

Another tour option for getting to know the city is a heritage tour, which often takes you to places that are not usually accessible to the public. They take place on the first weekend of every month, with different theme and route every month. Each heritage tour is devoted to a specific topic concerning the past or present of Košice and are in Slovak, Hungarian, English and Spanish. You can find out about the times, themes and tickets for heritage tours at the Košice Visitor Centre or from the website www.potulka.sk. The starting point for the tours is in front of the National Science Library at Hlavná street 10.

Popular tour themes: Košice during socialism / Symbols in Košice / Alleyway secrets / St. Michael's Chapel / Fires in Košice / Jewish Košice / Art Nouveau Košice / Underground Košice / St. Elisabeth Cathedral / Košice Hall of Fame. Dominican Church and monastery.

UNUSUAL TOURS

In addition to the traditional tours and heritage tours, you can also design your own tour. Just visit the Košice Visitor Centre, choose from the list of monuments that most interest you and so create your own route in Košice. For lovers of fine flavours, we have a culinary tour of the city just for you, by which you can get a true taste of Košice also through various specialties and dishes. Other tours include Medieval Košice, and the ever popular tour In the footsteps of Sándor Márai.

HERITAGE AND CITY WALKS - Top highlights of Košice

Discover the fascinating highlights of Košice with a spirit of history and famous legends. Visit the places where life has pulsed since the city was established, learn about a famous local, the city's patron, the place where the Košice government manifesto was drawn up, the local "radio", the harp theatre or the epitaph for the living. There will be no shortage of superlatives on this tour.

Tour information: the tour sets off from in front of the Košice Visitor Centre at Hlavná 59 and takes about 1.5 hours. The tour is led by an experienced guide in the language of your choice.

1 Dolná brána (Lower gateway)

The Dolná brána is so named for the underground museum complex with original gateway to the city and parts of the original town fortifications, which were established in the 2[™] half of the 13[™] century. It was uncovered when the main street Hlavná street was being reconstructed in 1996. Today, thanks to its unique atmosphere, the complex is now a place of exhibitions, receptions, various events, including the traditional Košice Wine Festival in September.

2 Gersterov dom (Gerster House)

The name of this Košice native will mean nothing to many people, but we might recognise the names of his works from geography lessons. Just a short distance from the exit from the underground museum you can witness the statue of Košice-born genius engineer Béla Gerster – designer of well-known ship-ways, canals and railways, including the Panama Canal or the Corinth Canal.

3 Župný dom

One of the features of palaces in Košice is the placement of coats-of-arms above the main facing. The coat-of-arms of the former Abov-Turniansky territorial unit from 1558 adorns the Župný Dom building, which served as administrative centre for the unit from 1779. It is now home to the East Slovak Gallery, and in addition to premises for art expositions, the Gallery houses an exquisite meeting room and the smallest public cinema in Košice.



4 City Coat-of-Arms

As you come out of the Gallery, you enter a small park. At the south end there is a bronze statue of the current Košice coat-of-arms. On the bottom left you can also see the original coat-of-arms from 1369, which is linked to one of the oldest royal deeds of its kind in Europe – the deed of King Louis the Great granting the coat-of-arms to the city, the first in Europe to receive such a privilege.



5 Dóm sv. Alžbety (St. Elisabeth Cathedral)

The symbolism of the city's patron is evident as soon as you visit St. Flisabeth Cathedral Construction work on the Cathedral started around 1380 on the site of an even older temple. It is one of the easternmost western-style Gothic cathedrals in Europe, as well as the biggest temple of worship in Slovakia. It houses the fascinating Altar of St. Elisabeth, a rare gothic double spiral staircase - one of just five of its kind in Europe (open to public), the crypt of the leader of the biggest anti-Habsburg uprising in the former Kingdom of Hungary, Francis II Rákóczi (open to the public), and also the outdoor sundial from 1477. The work of master stonemason Štefan. a local artist from the 15th century, adorn both the interior and exterior. Thanks to the fantastic view of the city centre, climbing the 60-metre high northern tower is well worth the effort. The latest research links the pompousness and logic of the construction of this church with the miracle of the Blood of Christ, which took place on these sites in the 14th century. The church has been visited for centuries by pilorims from all of Europe and in 1402 Pope Boniface IX confirmed that the relic of the blood of Christ had been preserved here. The holy mass in Latin on Sundays at 9 a.m. provides an excellent mixture of medieval architecture, the languagee of Medieval Europe and Baroque music.



6 Kaplnka sv. Michala (St. Michael's Chapel)

The chapel, which can be found south of St. Elisabeth Cathedral, comes from the $14^{\rm th}$ century. It represents the culmination of the gothic period and is surprising by its stylish precision, intimacy and harmony. At one time it was surrounded by the city cemetery and contained an ossuary. This is why it is devoted to the escort of souls to the other side, Archangel Michael, whose medieval statue portraying the judging of the dead souls is placed above the entrance to the chapel. Masses are also given in English at the chapel, every Sunday at 11:00.



7 Urbanova veža (St. Urban's Tower)

The bell-tower that houses a copy of the Bell of St. Urban, while the original from 1557 is in placed in front of St. Urban's Tower itself. Under the porticos there are gravestones representing rare examples of Antiquity, Gothic and Baroque art. The 45-metre high tower also contains the only museum of wax figurines in Slovakia, which will reveal the city's history to you also via its personalities.



8 Park with singing fountain and bell chimes

Every hour on the hour the park resounds with distinctive bell chimes from twenty two bells. From May to October the singing fountain adds to its melodies, with shooting jets of water at the end (illuminated at night) in rhythm to the calming music.

9 Štátne divadlo (State Theatre)

Taking a stroll around the fountain, you will come across the impressive entrance to the State Theatre building designed by architect Adolf Lang. The theatre put on its first performance back in 1899. In addition to the Neo-Baroque exterior with Art Nouveau elements, visitors will be enthralled by the wavy interior in the shape of a harp, the intimacy and greatness of the theatre, while beautiful components of Art Nouveau and scenes on the ceiling from four plays of world-renowned playwright William Shakespeare, created by Peregrin von Gastgeb from Vienna. Apart from the Slovak National Theatre in Bratislava, it is the only triple ensemble theatre in Slovakia (opera, balet, drama).



10 Immaculata (Plague Column)

Right behind the theatre you can find the Plague Column of the Virgin Mary from 1723 (Immaculata). The column is situated in a small park and commemorates the gratitude to Mother Mary for an end to the plague epidemic from 1709 and 1710. It is a fine example of a Baroque sculpture surrounded by later sculptures of saints and angels. According to historic documents, the bodily remains of St. Valentine were placed under one of the columns here.



11 Historická radnica (Old Town Hall)

The last stop on this tour takes in the historic town hall, which was built from 1779 to 1780 and has a distinct Košice coat-of-arms over the balcony. Inside we can find stunning halls and representational premises of the city mayor, with one of them containing an effigy to the first men of the city. Passing through the courtyard you will come to the former cinema Fórum/ Slovan, the reconstructed covered hall of which now serves for concerts and theatrical performances. The Košice Visitor Centre is situated on the ground floor.





HERITAGE AND CITY WALKS The Old Town Walk

An extension to the tour Top Highlights of Košice will take you to other places that are concealed from common tourists in the little side streets. You continue along to discover the medieval fortifications of Košice and the dungeon, the Košice house arrest prison for the unruly leader, the palace on the riverbank, the nooks and crannies of City Park, Košice's world renowned writer, the symbol and names of the winners of the Peace Marathon and the place where the golden treasure is to be found.

Tour information: The tour starts in front of the Košice Visitor Centre at Hlavná 59 and takes at about 2.5 hours. It is led by an experienced guide in the language of your choice.

12 Miklušova väznica (Mikluš Prison)

The original two gothic houses with well-reputed pottery workshop were converted in the 17th to the 19th centuries into a prison and torture chamber. In the adjacent underpass over Hrnčiarska street there is the Executioner's Flat (awarded as 2009 Exposition of the Year). Today it houses a museum with the exposition Košice through the centuries, where you can experience the mysterious medieval atmosphere. Every year during the event Night at the Museum, the prison comes to life with real wails and screams of prisoners and those being tortured.




13 The Executioner's Bastion and Rodošto Areál – commemorative house of Francis II Rákóczi

The most stunning example of medieval Košice bulwark and the largest bastion in Slovakia is the Katova bašta (Executioner's Bastion), which protected one of the entrance points to the city – Maľovaná brána (Painted Gateway). The grounds of the bastion are home to a copy of the Turkish exile home of the last leader of the anti-Habsburg uprising, Francis II Rákóczi, which is named after the former name of his place of exile Rodošto, and which brings a touch of the orient to Košice. If you are interested in your own commemorative coin, announce it in advance at the Rodošto mint and you will have a unique souvenir to take home from Košice.



14 Jakabov palác (Jakab Palace)

At the end of Mynska street opposite City Park, the site where the enchanting artificial brook called Mlynský náhon was originally created is now home to this charming palace. The palace was not the residence of some noble family, however, but the private house of well-known Košice builder Peter Jakab, who was also responsible for building the State Theatre building and the East Slovak Museum. In April 1945 the palace enjoyed its greatest heyday, when for over a month it was the residence of the president of the Czechoslovak Republic, Edvard Benes.



15 Mestský park

The City Park covering over 11 hectares is the gateway to the historic centre. It was established in the 18th century, and today popular sports areas and the city's swimming baths are on its outer edge. The park is vibrant especially in the summer, when it comes to life with the multimedia street theatre Imaginacie, and in the first week of October during the Festival of Lights, Nuit Blanche (White Night).



16 Márai's sculpture

The little side streets leading from City Park bring you to the sculpture of probably the most famous local of Košice – world-renowned author Sándor Márai, who spent his childhood and part of his teenage years in the city. The interactive sculpture shows him as he was, deep in contemplation. Just sit next to him...



17 The Marathoner sculpture and the International Peace Marathon

At the end of Hlavná street lies Námestie Maratónu mieru (Peace Marathon Square), which commemorates the oldest marathon in Europe. Its symbol is a running man made by the sculptor Arpád Račko, together with the names of the winners of individual years. You can take on the 42 km run through the city every year in the first weekend in October together with thousands of other

enthusiasts. If you don't feel up to it, you can register for the half marathon or mini marathon (4.2 km). You will never receive as big an applause as when you run through the Košice streets.

18 Východoslovenské múzeum (East Slovak Museum)

Right behind the marathon runner sculpture there is a majestic New Renaissance building of the East Slovak Museum from 1896 to 1899. The most active museum in Slovakia in terms of the number of exhibitions, with numerous expositions, hides a true jewel in its vaults (when not travelling round the world), namely the Košice Golden Treasure.

Opposite the building of the East Slovak Museum we can find one of the most stunning buildings in the city – the building Divizie, which was built for the military leaders and adorned with military attributes. Today it is the seat of the Košice Autonomous Region and houses expositions of East Slovak Museum with gems from the Gothic, Baroque and Renaissance periods, as well as some unique natural items from the Carpathians.



HERITAGE AND CITY WALKS The religious Košice

Admirers of sacral buildings and those seeking pious and tranquil places for contemplation can take the specially prepared tour entitled Religious Košice. You will witness the beauty of the most visited temple, St. Elisabeth Cathedral, or the most highly revered St. Michael's Chapel, but that's not all. You will also be captivated by the many stories, curiosities and treasures of less-known religious buildings, which take you on a journey through various architectonic styles – from Roman style, Gothic, through Renaissance and Baroque to rondo cubism.

Tour information: the tour starts in front of the Košice Visitor Centre at Hlavná 59 and takes about 2 hours. It is led by an experienced guide in the language of your choice.

19 Kostol najsvätejšej Trojice (University Church of the Holy Trinity – Church of the Premonstratensians)

The most vibrantly decorated church from 1681 is bursting with colours with a cross-section of renaissance and colourful baroque interior. It is typified by more personal access to God, reificated in the segregated side chapels with altars, which means everybody can pray in privacy. The church itself with annexed monastery and erstwhile university is interesting also for the illusion of the front wall by Erasmus Schrött, by a rare carved pulpit from the 17th century, or stunning ceiling murals with scenes linked to the founder of the order of premonstrants. St. Norbert.



20 Kostol sv. Antona Paduánskeho (Church of St. Anthony of Padua, referred to as the Seminary Church)

The longest and second oldest church in Košice was originally established by the Franciscans at the end of the 14th century. Firstly a church, then a weapons store, barracks, a food store, a temporary cathedral – the temple went through all these stages until eventually returning to the original function, while having the honour in 1995 of welcoming Pope John Paul II, who briefly wandered also in the adjacent building of the convent. In addition to holy masses all year round, you should not miss out on the Christmas concert if you get a chance, as it is a truly magnificent experience.


The church is equipped also with the largest mechanical **ruženec in Slovakia. Its carved figures move, gradually revealing individual secrets of the painful, joyful, ceremonial and **ba i ruženca svetla.

21 Dominikánsky kostol (Dominican Church)

From the temples of Hlavná street we move to the well-known Dominikánske námestie (Dominican Square) with market, which takes its names from the oldest church in the city from 13th century. Next to the church there was also a monastery, which in the 14th century housed a school and a renowned limner workshop. There are numerous curiosities here: the fascinating frescos on the walls of the church create the illusion as if it doesn't even have a roof, while its underground section was used for burials, but also as a hideaway at the end of World War II. Under the carpet you will find swastika symbols, and there are false cracks on the walls ...

22 Synagogue on Zvonárska street with prayer room and mikvah – the Jewish congregation

Among the houses on the side street Zvonárska street stands the rather inconspicuous building of the oldest preserved synagogue in Košice from 1883 – a fine example of Moorish style. Right next to it, is the entrance to the Košice Jewish religious congregation and the prayer building. The courtyard contains the Rabbi's apartment, the premises and former flat for the shochet (the person who ritually slaughters the animals and sells the meat from them), a kosher canteen and the office of the congregation, as well as the oldest ritualistic pool, a mikvah, in Slovakia.

23 Synagogue and school on Puškinova Street

The whole tour culminates with the reconstructed orthodox synagogue and adjacent Jewish school. The buildings are the work of well-known Košice architect Ľudovít Oelschläger and the builder Hugo Kaboš from the end of the 1930s. The orthodox synagogue is a specific combination of historic elements, with touches of oriental architecture together with modern elements. The interior walls of the synagogue are inscribed in pencil with the comments of Jews who were gathered there before being transported to the concentration camps. It is the only synagogue in Košice to have served its religious purpose perpetually. In the basement of the adjacent school Talmud Tóry there used to be a well-known matzo bakery.



HERITAGE AND CITY WALKS – The Jewish Košice

Before the holocaust, the city of Košice was one of the biggest and most prominent Jewish congregations in present-day Slovakia. In 1930 it was home to over 11,500 Jews, who made up 16.4% of the total population of the city, while the Jews were not allowed to settle in the city until after 1840. Yet it took under three weeks in 1944 for almost the whole Jewish community to be shipped off in transporters to Auschwitz-Birkenau and other concentration camps. They left their monuments as a legacy, though, enhancing the city and telling their own sombre stories. By their beauty, atmosphere and uniqueness, the Jewish monuments make this tour a truly unique experience.

24 Dom umenia (House of Art – formerly the neological synagogue)

We set off on this thematic Jewish tour in front of the House of Art, which from 1867 was the site of the beautiful building of the first synagogue in Košice, which was eventually razed to the ground at the beginning of the 1960s. Between 1926 and 1927 a neological synagogue was erected next to it with a capacity for 1100 people and a huge elliptical dome with diameters of 21m and 24m, reminiscent of the Roman Pantheon, which has been preserved unchanged to the present day. Since being converted, it has served as the home of the State Philharmonic in Košice. An interesting feature is that the top of the dome was once home to a six-pointed star of David, which is now to be found on the holocaust memorial in the Jewish cemetery (on Rastislavova street). The star was replaced by a lute.



25 School building on Tajouského street

The school building was functionally linked to the synagogue on the first floor. It has a very impressive facade and its restored appearance can be enjoyed directly from the street. It was once an educational centre for some of the Košice Jews.

22 Synagogue on Zvonárska street with prayer room and mikvah – the Jewish congregation

26 The old puppet theatre – Jewish casino

In 1893 the Jews in Košice set up the Košice social circle, so-called Jewish casino and in 1910 they had a separate Art Nouveau palace built. It housed social rooms and a cafe. After the war and a conversion, from 1962 until the beginning of the 1990s it was used as a puppet theatre.



23 Synagogue and school on Puškinova street



Old and new Jewish cemetery

Every Jewish religious congregation had its own cemetery quite a distance away from the synagogue. The Košice one had its on Tatranska street, with it serving from 1844 to 1877. This is the burial place also of the parents of famous Jewish painter Leopold Holowitz. Today the cemetery covers an area of just 50 x 70 m. The new Jewish cemetery is located next to the public cemetery on Rastislavova street. In the middle of it stands a monument to the victims of the holocaust, which contains also a six-pointed star from the former Neological synagogue, now home to the House of Art.

Wartime Jewish ghetto

On what today is Bajzova street close to the bus station there was a transit Jewish ghetto during the war, where the Jews from Košice and the surrounding villages were congregated. The street was closed off and life was concentrated only on the space between the walls of the two square buildings with courtyards.

MUSEUMS AND ATTRACTIONS Košice museums

There is a rich choice of museums in Košice with something for everyone. For lovers of archaeology there is the underground below Hlavná street or the example of digging sites in Nižná Myšťa. Košice's position on key medieval trading routes, the golden treasure, period art and life, can all be found in the oldest museum in Košice, established in 1872. You can see famous personalities from history in life-sized wax figures at the only wax museum in Slovakia, and a memorial room for one of the city's best-known natives. In addition to an exhibition of the works of renowned Košice sculptor, the Vojtech Löffler Museum maps out the current direction of the contemporary art scene and gives space to young artists. Those visitors interested in science and research will be pleased with the only technical museum here, which in addition to the main building, offers many other interesting places to admire the stars, clocks or aircraft. The customs and folklore of the Abov county (historic territorial unit corresponding to Košice environs) are revealed in the unique ethnographic museum HUMNO. Submerge into the various worlds in Košice and get closer to nature, history or even the stars.

ARCHAEOLOGY FOREMOST

Right at the beginning of Hlavná street there is the Underground archaeological museum, which reveals one of the original gateways to the city from the 13th century, together with other historic fortifications, bulwark and buildings. You can be taken even further back in history by the Nižná Myšľa Local Museum, where you can find local digging sites from the settlement of primeval hunters of moose and mammoth and their graves from 3,500 years ago.



Underground archaeology museum – Dolná brána

An underground museum complex with original gateway to the city and original fortifications from the 13th to the 15th century, which were uncovered during reconstruction work on Hlavná street in 1996.

Nižná Myšľa Local Museum

A museum situated in the building of the former Myšľa monastery can be found in the nearby village of Nižná Myšľa, where in 1977 extensive research was carried out on the Late Bronze Age settlement and graveyard – the oldest settlement in Slovakia. Don't miss out on a tour of the exhibits that moose and mammoth hunters had in their houses and which they used to bury with their loved ones. These include the likes of the best-known and oldest toy to be found in Slovakia – a clay cart. You can also investigate the underground catacomb of the monastery.

NATURE, HISTORY, TREASURE, ART AND PERSONALITIES

You can find out about the nature of the Carpathians, the art and history of Košice, the historical figure of Francis II Rákôczi and the medieval prison with Executioner's Flat at the **East Slovak Museum in Košice**, which organises various thematic exhibitions in its four buildings in the historic city centre. Starting again in 2013, visitors to the museum will enjoy the exposition called Košice Gold Treasure. Wax figures of the most famous personalities of Košice make up the exposition at the only Slovak **Wax Museum** in St. Urban's Tower. The birth and life of world-renowned author Sándor Márai is recollected in his **Memorial Room** on Mäsiarska street. **The museum** of the excellent Košice sculptor and promoter of art Vojtech Liffler celebrates his artistic works.

ART SCENE AND CULTURE – Art scene

In terms of art and culture, Košice actively works on making sure it is a successful European Capital of Culture 2013. Proof of this can be seen in the whole range of developing artistic projects, new festivals, events and activities being organised in the city for 2013. The sheer quantity of international events, as well as the growing creative community, confirm that Košice has and will have a firm place on the creative map of Europe. Vladimír Beskid, Artistic director of the non-profit organisation Košice – European Capital of Culture 2013, will tell us why it is worth visiting Košice as the capital of culture.

"The key ambition and long-term goal of the project INTERFACE 2013 is to transform and develop the city through a powerful cultural injection, active co-involvement of residents from the city and the East Slovak region, while improving relations between them. This mostly concerns the creation of a core platform for co-forming a new creative and active place of culture at the turn of the 21st century, a new "hot spot" of culture in Central Europe. We revitalised many redundant buildings in the city and are breathing an atmosphere of creativity and fellowship into them. Today, we see the key moments as being the creation of a new cultural infrastructure, which brings a new model of institution to Slovakia (Kasárne/Kulturpark, Kunsthalle/Hala umenia, SPOTs), the creation of a new "intelnet" (intellectual network), the natural mobility of artists and artistic thought, the many innovative projects and events of a European scale and with potential for further development."



If you are looking for exciting cultural experiences in Košice, the dilemma is not about what to do, but where to start. The theatre or the gallery, modern or classic, pleasantly tranquil or a swinging party; if you are not sure what you want to experience, take a piece of advice – stay in Košice the whole weekend and try something from everything.

Opera, ballet and drama are all on offer at the **State Theatre Košice**, which in addition to the historical building also puts unique shows on at its **Mala scéna (small stage)**. The programme is full of quality performances (some with awards) and fantastic comedies, such as the continually sold-out performances of **Tom, Dick and Harry** starring the excellent actor Michal Soltész. The ballet troupe, currently ranked the best in Slovakia, offers classic and modern dance performances. Košice Opera also guarantees an unforgettable experience, often prepared by distinguished host directors. The **Thália Színház Theatre** and **Márai Stúdió** put on performances in Hungarian, including works of Sándor Márai. Not only children of all ages will appreciate the **Bábkové divadlo (Puppet**

theatre) with the unique performance of Jorik, where the performance is played out in the whole theatre hall, creating a different atmosphere every time. Irregular performances are put on by other theatre groups and scenes such as the Staromestské divadlo (Old Town Theatre), Cassia Dance Theatre or the professional theatre of the Roma minority Romathan. The Na peróne Theatre is an independent theatre group that deals with new themes in an innovative way, and is involved in various projects at home and abroad.

The theatre scene in Košice will definitely charm you by its quality, but the city will also captivate you by its visual arts. The foundation of this is the East Slovak Gallery, which in two buildings (on Hlavná and Alžbetina streets) presents the very best of classical fine art (Košice modern and other) over a broad spectrum of genres, while also giving space to the new generation of artists. The gallery premises on Alžbetina street is right next to the Vojtech Löffler Museum, which is a gallery and museum. Among other things, it houses a collection of works from this highly esteemed sculptor. The thematic collection of works of a specific artist is also offered by the private gallery of the guru of pop-art Andy Warhol, the Mihal Gallery. Creative Košice also refers to Kasárne/Kulturpark and TABAČKA KulturFabrik. An interestingly creative venue is the Rotunda. which houses various exhibitions, foremost of the Academy of applied art. Contemporary art can be found at the Panoptikum Gallery, while photography is the topic at the FotoGaléria NOVA. You can go to view and even buy works of art at the Unicon-art-gallery, DieloPlus.sk or KMG - ART.



Košice has several places also when it comes to choosing film screenings. Set off to either the multiplex CineMax in the Optima shopping centre or Ster Century Cinemas in the Galéria shopping centre. You can also watch screenings at the cinema Biograf, which is part of the East Slovak Museum. Literary art is most present at the National science library and Youth library, which organises also various workshops and meetings. You can enjoy an untraditional excursion or lecture organised by the State Archives in Košice.

From eyes to ears: classical music is catered for by the regular programme of the **State Philharmonic Košice** (mostly Thursdays). Various concerts and performances take place at the **STEEL ARENA** (with some of the biggest stars, like Faithless, Andrea Bocelli or Lenny Kravitz), the **Infiniti Arena**, the sports hall **Cassosport**, **Agentúra GeS**, **Jumbo centrum**, **Old Town Hall** or at the club **Collosseum** (alternative music – from reggae to hardcore). The programme of exhibitions, concerts and other events is complemented also by the likes of the **Youth library** or the **Culture centre of Košice autonomous region**.

ART SCENE AND CULTURE – Košice – European Capital of Culture 2013

A new artistic chapter in Košice comes in the shape of the two cultural institutions Kasárne/Kulturpark and Kunsthalle, which embody the potential of creativity. They provide a platform for the development of artists, activities and all those who want to be part of the new cultural scene in Košice and the project European Capital of Culture 2013.

Kasárne/Kulturpark

With the transformation of the estate of the former barrack stores of Capt. Jaroš, a venue was established for various cultural functions that were lacking in the city. Kasárne/Kulturpark is the heart of the project Košice – European Capital of Culture 2013 and the premises have been transformed into a modern independent cultural and artistic centre for all fields of art and age groups. The mission of the Kasárne/Kulturpark is also to support local upcoming artists, to develop their artistic skills, provide space for presenting their works, while also creating the platform for creative coperation between business and art in the East Slovak region, in line with trends of a creative economy of the 21st century. Kasárne/Kulturpark wants to go even further when it comes to the concept of developing creativity. It wants to convert the passive audience into active participants of artistic programmes and establish a Centre of Education in creativity and culture, and city exhibition premises.

Kasárne (The Barracks)

The Kasárne, or barracks, is now home to the cultural centre Kulturpark – culture centre. Every month it prepares an attractive multi-genre programme made up of concerts, workshops, lectures, performances, screenings and exhibitions. Kulturpark enjoys co-operation in the creation of the cultural programme and its operation from various entities – civil initiatives, formal groups, or companies, such as Bona Fide, the Na peróne Theatre, Pectus publishing house, MakeUp collective, Kassaboys or Artarch. Kasárne/Kulturpark also hosts international events in the area of contemporary art.

Centre of Education in creativity and culture

The aim of the centre is to provide support to organisations and companies dealing with various kinds of creative activity and the creation of a synergic effect by concentrating them in one place, i.e. the reconstructed premises of the former barracks will be rented out cheap to upcoming and active artists, companies and other entities in the sphere of culture, art and creative industry, including media, and they will also serve for the presentation of works and for education in the field of cultural management.






City exhibition premises

This project focuses on the creation of a new municipal institution with specific programme, which complements the cultural infrastructure of the city by much needed modern premises. It will be split into a museum and a gallery, which will document the transformation of society toward democracy and human liberty, and its artistic manifestations, including reflection. The **Gallery** will be used for presentations of visual art from the Centre of Education in creativity and culture and for projects as part of the overall concept of the Kasárne/Kulturpark.

The year 2013 therefore means new cultural and artistic premises for Kasárne/Kulturpark, together with projects that will breathe a creative spirit into the abandoned army barracks, producing a special atmosphere. You should definitely make a visit.

Kunsthalle/ Hall of Art

The Kunsthalle project – the reconstruction of the old covered swimming baths resolves the establishment of a modern cultural and artistic space. From the perspective of focus, the project is targeted chiefly at international exhibitions of visual arts, artistic objects and new media. By preserving the water element, the Kunsthalle becomes a unique place. It strongly supports the creation and presentation of new original forms of art that do not have such an opportunity elsewhere in Košice or Slovakia. The old swimming baths is designed as the single operation of the Kunsthalle – a multifunctional cultural centre with different premises that can be mutually separated.



FUN FOR FAMILY – Fun for family

Košice with its interesting attractions and events is a fun place where you can do sports, discover new things and enjoy good food... No wonder children love Košice. Explore it and have fun with them! Košice can offer more than appears at first sight. Roman Sorger, founder of the children's project Haliganda Country, will convince you of this.

"Our friends coming to Košice with their children envy us for many things they do not have in other towns. The **Jazero** lake, here you can take a stroll, skate in winter or summer, swim or try out water-skis. Sundays in the city centre combined with a visit to the Puppet theatre, State Theatre, chocolate house, strolling along the pedestrian zone with an ice-cream at the singing fountain, are all great ends or beginnings to the week. Many families with children from Košice and the surroundings seek out events capturing the local atmosphere of the city, such as Summer in the Park, with theatre performances, concerts and creative workshops, Nuit Blanche full of lights and unusual installations in the city, **Night at the Museum** with the unforgettable atmosphere of the city at night and museums full of parents and children, and our festival Haliganda Country full of exhibitions, unusual concerts for children, creative workshops, theatre performances from Poland, Slovakia, the Czech Republic and Hungary, as well as various Town Walks. Košice is a fantastic place with **many little secrets** that are worth exploring with the kids. A bus can take you to the city suburb of Šaca where you do not look for US Steel, however, but explore two manor houses with your children, especially the old mill with preserved mechanisms. Different public transport connections will take you on a visit to the archaeological site in Nižná Myšľa with local museum. If you spend more time in the city, definitely visit some of the maternity centres that organise programmes for the whole family alongside their other projects."



Having arrived in Košice, places for children are situated only a little apart. Plan your exciting day or weekend. Whether it is raining or the sun is shining, whether you have a curious little person at home or a demanding teenager, Košice is the ideal place to spend your time together.

An ideal to start your city walk is "The most beautiful gems of Košice" thematic tour, which will take you and your children through the most beautiful places of the main street in a quick way that will not bore you. If you prefer a new experience from the very start – go to the East Slovak Museum to see the exhibition of Carpathian Nature. The

old prison Mikluš Prison with wax figures of prisoners and an authentic torture chamber, as well as the Executioner's Flat, voted the best Slovak exhibition of 2009, promise an educational experience, or will at least scare the small rascals a little bit. Older children and little explorers will be thrilled at the displays of Slovak Technical Museum, in particular by its Sieň elektrických výbojov (Chamber of electric charge). You can choose from various directions from the centre: to the north for the Botanical Gardens, where great exhibitions take place every month (from orchids or butterflies to spiky cacti) or to Kavečany where you will find Košice Zoo, the dry toboggan run and an entertainment centre (trampolines and monkey bars). Heading in this direction, you can stop and explore the grounds of Košice Castle, which is 1.5 times more extensive than Spiš Castle, and marvel at the view from the Watchtower.

You have two choices in the direction of **Čermel**': either hop on the amazing old **Children's railway** and be transported to the recreation area **Alpínka**, a beautiful forest park with children's playground and high rope park Tarzania, and a **golf course** for the more mature of us. Or you can climb a hill to the traditional relaxation spot of the people from Košice – **Bankov**, where you can play mini golf, take a stroll to the **spring** and the **chapel**, sit on the terrace around a children's playground or swim in the pool of the **oldest Slovak hotel**.

In the north-east of the city the Hornád River borders the popular park Anička where you can find a children's play area with mini golf, playgrounds, a maze and children's motorbike rental. A festive spring ritual to "unlock the waters" takes place in the park in April on Earth Day.

In the opposite direction to the south, young sports enthusiasts can head off to the **Sports and Entertainment Centre** on Alejová street where there is a **children's traffic playground**, the most modern and professional concrete **skate park** unparalleled in Slovakia, **an ice-rink** and other **sports fields**.

Further south the **Aviation Museum** is situated near the airport. You can plan your visit with children in September, for instance, for the **Retro Air Show** combined with **an air show by vintage planes**.

Another ideal place for relaxing and doing sports is situated to the south of Košice, in the suburb called Nad Jazerom – a lake area with more playgrounds, sports fields, a cycling trail that can also be used for in-line skating along the Hornád River, a high rope park, a beach and a water-ski tow line where children can try out water skiing or hydro-skidding.

Enjoy adrenaline and more fun with a **hot air balloon flight over Košice**, a **graffiti ride**, **by historic** or **devilish tram**, and horse riding at the ranch **Ranč Ortáše** and in **Zelené údolie near Alpínka**, or a hiking trip to the chalet **Lajoška**.



You can come to Košice with your family for specific events: for the little ones we recommend the Bábkové divadlo (Puppet Theatre), as well as workshops, playrooms and meetings in the maternity centres Haliganda or Stonožka, creative workshops for promising artists in the East Slovakia Gallery or events for children such as Košice Days, Košice Gourmet Fest, Summer in the park, International Peace Marathon (you can run a mini marathon with your children) or the World Cosmic Week. The Domino free-time centre, libraries and the State Theatre Košice also prepare programmes for older kids. On a rainy day you can take them to the cinema in the shopping centre Optima to see a 3D film.

Teenagers might like and get inspired by **Use the City** festival, the **skate park on Alejová street, hockey matches in STEEL ARÉNA.** If your child likes classical music, they could very well enjoy **festivals of classical music** (Košice Musical Spring, the International organ Festival or the Contemporary Music Festival).

Botanical Gardens

Fascinating university gardens where over 4,000 species of plant are cultivated, including 1,200 cactuses and their cultivars, which is the largest collection of its kind in either the Czech or Slovak republics. You can soak up the tropical heat of the greenhouses and get a feel of what it is like in a rain forest, and enjoy the expansive outdoor gardens. When visiting the botanical gardens you should definitely try to see one of the thematic exhibitions such as the magical exhibition of orchids, tropical butterflies, cactuses, camivorous plants or the ever popular presentation of Bonsai.

The Watchtower and Castle

At the northern edge of Košice on Hradová hill (castle hill), a 21-m high watchtower has jutted out above the city since 1986. Once you overcome the 99 steps, you will be rewarded with a truly inspiring panorama of the whole of Košice. The remains of the medieval castle cover an area of 6.2 hectares, which is 1.5 times more than the area of Spiš Castle. The locality of Hradová near the Watchtower and the surrounding forest park are ideal spots for a picnic or barbecue, with specially designated places for this and for making fires.



SPORT – Get close to the action

Košice lives for sport. Whether you want to root for professionals or do sports actively yourself, Košice offers a wide range of possibilities. Popular Košice hockey personality Peter Bartoš will tell you about his tips of where to go for sports.



Choose any sport you like, you will be thrilled how close you are to a sports event in Košice. Be it hockey, basketball, handball, skiing, tennis, the beach or water skiing – you find everything in the city!

Fans make true sport

Košice is a dream destination for any hockey fan: not only was it host to the Ice Hockey World Championship 2011, but the city also has the most loyal fan base in Slovakia – electrifying matches of the local **HC Košice in Steel Arena** (Nerudova 12/www.steelarena.sk) are attended by around 6,000 spectators, which is one of the top thirty attendance rates in Europe! The modern Steel Arena is child-friendly, tickets are reasonably priced and the atmosphere is always amazing! HC Košice is known for rewarding the support of its fans – it became Slovak champion in the 2008/2009, 2009/2010 and 2010/2011 seasons.

Speaking about the great atmosphere, why stop at hockey and miss the European matches of Košice women's basketball team at the Infiniti arena (Pri jazdiarni 1), the water-polo team at the public indoor swimming pool Mestská krytá plaváreň (Protifašistických bojovníkov 4) or the men's handball team at the city handball hall Mestská hádzanárska hala VŠA (Alejová 2). You can come and root for the unbelievable marathon runners at the International Peace Marathon, or support rally champions in Košice competitions, as well as water-skiers, wake-boarders and wake-skaters who rank top in Slovakia, Europe and even the world.

If watching games and sport performances is not active enough for you, take your kit and find your own sport experience in Košice. Here is a choice of the hest:

Hockey and ice-skating

You can enjoy public ice-skating and hockey at the public ice-rink in the Sport and Entertainment Area at Alejová street 2, or play it big and rent an hour at the STEEL ARENA for you and your team.

Skiing

Winter sports are very popular in Slovakia and so there are many skiing centres in towns around. The natives of Košice often spend time at the ski centres of **Kavečany** (www.kavecany.sk) and **Jahodná** (www.jahodna.sk) or Skipark Erika just 20 km away at **Kojšova Hoľa** (www.skiparkerika.sk), which has cross-country tracks as well. Kavečany and Jahodná are also suitable for beginners.



Golf and mini-golf

A nine-hole golf course at Alpínka is surrounded by the beautiful scenery of the Čermel Valley. The course is characterised by its narrow fairways and difficult putting. It is an ideal place to relax after a hard day at work. Golf enthusiasts will enjoy hole no. 3, which is a coastal design with water obstacle to the hole. Another golf course is under construction in Malá Ida near Košice. In winter you can try out a golf simulator. Mini-golf can be played in Bankov, Anička Park and at Rastislavova street 8.

Cycling and mountain bikes

The beautiful forest parks of Košice and the banks of the Hornád River provide tens of kilometres of bike trails for your pleasure. Town bikers can have fun riding through the main street Hlavná ulica, stopping for an ice-cream or on the new cycling lane in Moyzesova artificial park, while more ambitious cyclists might prefer a ride to Bankov or Jahodná, in the direction of Kojšova Hoľa, Bukovec or southwards to the Slanské vrchy hills. You can get cycling tips at www.visitkosice.eu.

Squash and tennis

Košice offers a number of courts with different surfaces, like at the Cassosport Sports Centre (Alejová 11), Sport and Leisure Centre (Alejová 2), Tenis Komplex in the KVP suburb (Wuppertálska 4), Tennis club BD (Gemerská 3), in summer near TRITON swimming pool (Rastislavova 69) and at the city swimming pool Mestská plaváreň (Rumanova 19). Squash enthusiasts can enjoy a game at several clubs, the biggest being Arcadia Sport Club in the Ťahanovce suburb (Americká 19).

Swimming pools

Ideal places for swimming and sun-bathing in the summer include the beach at Jazero lake, the city swimming pool Mestská plaváreň in the centre close to the City Park, the swimming pool Ryba near Anička Park (Pod Šiancom 3) and the swimming baths Triton. The indoor pool Mestská krytá plaváreň with an Olympic-size swimming pool is open throughout the year. The little ones can enjoy the pool at the Via vitae wellness centre (Diamantová 1) with slightly salty water or a pool at Barca and Hotel Bankov. Anglers can enjoy the beautiful countryside not far from the city at the water reservoir Bukovec.



Hornád River Trips

Even in Košice and the surrounding area you can get your adrenalin going with an adventurous trip down the river in a canoe, kayak or raft. Everyone can find something different in the water – a desire to discover, to spend time at places you would otherwise not reach, to get an unparalleled view, or just to enjoy the flow of the river and get some active relaxation with some light activity. Even though the river Hornád is suitable for beginners, it should not be underestimated. An experienced team of Košice experts will prepare you for the trip and accompany you for the whole journey. Once you get enough experience, you can take on a more demanding river next time.

Water-ski /Wakeboard/ Wakeskate/ Windsurfing

The water-ski tow line area in the Nad Jazerom district is home to the Trixen water-ski club and the Evils club of wakeboarders and wakeskaters. Every year various competitions are held here. The tow is open in the summer and anyone can give it a try – there is an equipment rental available as well. A friendly tow-attendant will instruct you how to set off correctly and survive your first round successfully. Do not get discouraged by professional jumps and the tricks of local talent; the atmosphere around the tow is supportive and friendly. Košice is home for well-known windsurfer and Olympic contestant Patrik Pollák. Another favourite place where you can enjoy these sports is the gravel lake Geča. It is not far from the city and is known for its excellent wind conditions.



Skateboarding

Košice is home to Slovakia's most modern skate park on Alejová street and several smaller skate parks (in Ťahanovce). Skateboarding is part of the Use the City street-art festival.

A DIFFERENT FLAVOUR EVERY DAY – CHOOSE BY YOUR MOOD

Day one - Slovak cuisine

Start with some traditional Slovak dishes. At least you will find out whether our cheeses and especially bryndza sheep cheese, are a nice one time treat or if they become a favourite for the rest of your life. The most popular meals made from bryndza sheep cheese are "bryndzové halušky", sheep-cheese gnocchi and "bryndzové pirohy", ravioli-style pasta filled with bryndza. Do not forget to sample a soup, because no Slovak lunch is complete without it. Check if the menu offers a Christmas sauerkraut soup, bean soup with smoked meat, or less known but still excellent mushroom soup called "mačanka".

Where to pop in? Day two – Czech, Hungarian and Polish cuisine

Continue your exploration of Central European cuisines. First in line is our neighbours, in the Czech Republic with the steamed dumpling "knedla", spicy Hungarian cuisine and meaty Polish dishes.

Where to pop in? Czech cuisine: **Budvarka** – Hrnčiarska 25, **Česká hospoda** – Moyzesova 22, **Pivovar Golem** – Dominikánske námestie 15; Polish cuisine: **Med Malina** – Hlavná 81; Hungarian cuisine: **Reštaurácia Faraón** – Jesenná 3.

Day three - Mediterranean cuisine

After a caloric shock you would need a day of taking it lighter. Even in Košice you can find simple Mediterranean cuisine full of excellent tastes.

Where to go? Olive Tree – Hlavná 3, Mediterran – Alžbetina 24 and La

Ventana – Hlavná 90 and Le Colonial – Hlavná 8.



Day four - European cuisine

The majority of restaurants serve European cuisine. Choose by your mood or where you are at any particular moment.

Where to stop and eat? Make a route through the city and try out various establishments. A number of them serve excellent European cuisine. Get inspired with the culinary trail of the city (page 45).



Day five - Italian cuisine and pizza

Popular Italian cuisine can be found in many places in Košice in its original and naturalised variations. It's up to you to choose.



Day seven – less traditional cuisines

Greek at **Korfu Gril** – Pribinova 2, partly Oriental at **Emir** – Hlavná 92 and Israeli at **Burekas** – Vrátna 58, an Asian restaurant serving sushi: **Grace** – Štúrova 33, pasta from various parts of the world at **Noodles** – Hotel Yasmin, Tyršovo nábrežie 1, ranchers ´ food in **Grill Pub** – Timonova 13. Other restaurants usually have special days dedicated to different global cuisines.

Now the only place where beer is brewed, even if the beer-brewing tradition goes as far back as the 15th century.

MARKETS

Every morning from spring till autumn the square **Dominikánske námestie** and the marketplace **Trhovisko Hradbová** come to life, full of fruit, vegetables, flowers and other homemade products (as well as on other occasions – for instance, before All Saints ´ Day or before Christmas). The best market takes place on a Saturday morning.





SHOP 'TIL YOU DROP - Buy yourself something special

Košice is definitely the best shopping place in the whole region. There are several shopping malls and centres throughout the city, just waiting for you to enter. The main street Hlavná ulica is inviting for a promenade, as well as side streets hiding designer label shops and souvenirs, together with some special places, posing as the shop window of the city and giving you a different shopping feeling. Don't hesitate and buy yourselves something special to remind you of your visit to Košice!

SHOPPING MALLS

The people of Košice love to shop and spend their free time in shopping malls. These shopping centres house shops of all major brands of your interest - from bijouterie through underwear, shoes, sportswear and equipment, bookstores, house accessories to toys. If you want to join the natives at their favourite shopping spots, go to OC Aupark (Námestie osloboditeľov), OC Optima (Moldavská cesta 32), OC Galéria (Toryská 5) or OC Cassovia (Pri prachárni 4).



SHOPPING CENTRES AND PASSAGES OF THE MAIN STREET HLAVNÁ ULICA

Specialised furniture, house appliances and electronics shops are very popular. There are also shopping centres full of smaller shops on the main street (**Dargov** - Hlavná 2, **OD Tesco** - Hlavná 111) or in **the passage near Doubletree by Hilton Hotel** (Hlavná 1).

HLAVNÁ ULICA (MAIN STREET)

The main street and the passages of its buildings are full of shop windows with jewellery, designer and other clothes and shoes, books, music and other interesting or useful things.

SIDE STREETS - SEEK THEM OUT

Sometimes you have to search for quality, and the same is true of Košice. Small streets hide ateliers of city designers and charming little shops.

SPECIAL PLACES

Occasionally, you can buy nice things at unusual places or at various events. Once a month on the Saturday nearest to the 15th of the month, an **Antique fair** is organised in the village of Budimír five kilometres away from Košice, then there is the **Hlavná**, **Staromestská and Christmas markets**, and in August there is **BaZZart** – a festival of original brands and design...

OPENING TIMES AND NON-STOP SHOPPING

Shops in the city centre are usually open from 9 a.m. or 10 a.m. until 6 p.m. during workdays and from 8 a.m. till 12 a.m. on Saturdays. They are mostly closed on Sundays. Shopping malls are open from 10 a.m. till 9 p.m. on week days and from 9 a.m. till 9 p.m. at weekends. Hypermarket Tesco is open non-stop, just in case you need something urgently.

If you want a beer, why not try Golem (Dominikánske námestie 15) where they serve their own brewed beer and snacks, Buějovická hospoda (Hrnčiarska 25) where you can also watch sports matches, the original The Beer House (Hlavná 54) Pub u kohúta (Hrnčiarska 23) with summer terrace, Irish Pub Diesel (Hlavná 92) serving the Irish specialty Guinness, underground AMSTERDAM (Štúrova 33 opposite STEEL ARÉNA) and Česká hospoda (Moyzesova 22), the small pub F Caffé (Baštová 11) or historic-style Keltská krčma (Hlavná 80), Villa Regia (Dominikánske námestie 3) and Camelot (Kováčska 19). The afternoon number one in the summer is Cambridge (Komenského), of course, besides the many summer terraces on the main street Hlavná ulica, the terraces of Blue Bell (Hlavná 22) and buffet stalls near the Jazero lake.

You can revel in good wine in stylish wine cellars. GATEWAY TO EAST SLOVAKIA - Trips to the region

Having arrived as far as Košice, we advise you not to leave without seeing the beautiful surroundings of the city. Košice is the gateway to the region, which is rich in numerous unique natural or cultural and historical sights. Take a trip back into mysterious medieval times, climb into majestic castles and manor houses, marvel at the underground kingdom of UNESCO-protected caves, nature reservoirs or traditional folk arts and crafts. Sample some delicious Tokaj wine directly at the vineyards and unparalleled medieval cellars, which conceal the secrets of its production. More tips by Miška Macíková from the family winery Tokaj Macík.

"The Tokaj region where I grew up is unique for me. Why? The TOKAJ winemaking region is a special and unique area of the world where the sun and earth unite so that men can produce great wine. The climatic conditions and the unique character of the region located at the confluence of the two rivers Bodrog and Tisa has been known since the 13th century thanks to the delicate beverage called Tokaj. I love the region, there is still plenty to discover, many marvellous places to experience and visit. You should therefore not skip visiting the medieval cellars combined with wine tasting, a tour of the manor house of the Andrássy Family, a boat trip on the River Bodrog and the unique experience of watching European pond turtles in the national nature reserve Tajba. I am glad I was born here. The region is close to my heart with the vineyards spreading over the slopes of the Zemplínske vrchy hills and large medieval cellar realms underneath, where wine silently matures in oak vats. The wine is rare not only thanks to its age, but mostly because of its composition and volume of antioxidants, vitamins, flavanoids and antimicrobial substances which are products of the refined fungus Botrytis cinerea Persson. It will be an unforgettable experience to visit Malá Tŕňa, the very heart of the Tokaj region and taste Tokaj wine underground. No wonder French King Louis XIV awarded the village the title of VINUM REGUM, REX VINORUM / Wine of kings, king of wines."



Take an organised one-day or half-day trip from Košice through the region.

An absorbing commentary from your guide will help you learn about the legends and stories, you will taste local specialties and leave full of new experiences. We have prepared trips to UNESCO Monuments of the Spiš region, Castles and UNESCO caves of the Gemer region, Unique Tokaj cellars and vineyards, as well as trips to the national parks Slovenský raj and Pieniny, and a tour of Wooden Churches of Eastern Slovakia.

1. UNESCO MONUMENTS OF THE SPIŠ REGION

A visit to the Spiš region will definitely be one of the highlights in your travel tales. Embraced by the Tatra mountains and Slovenský raj national park, the region can boast several cultural and historical monuments added to the UNESCO World Heritage List.

Our journey begins in the medieval town of **Levoča** with its treasure of the historical centre protected by a well-preserved fortification. You will get an insight into the life of the famous **sculpture Master Pavol of Levoča** or the mysterious **White Lady of Levoča**. Our route leads directly from the picturesque religious town of **Spišská Kapitula** (also referred to as the Slovak Vatican), where you can admire Roman and Gothic architecture, to **Spišský hrad (Spiš Castle)** which is one of the most remarkable monuments in Europe. At the end of the day you will take delight in the unique preserved frescos from the 14th century in the church **Kostol sv. Ducha (Church of the Holy Spirit) in the village of Žehra**. *Trip duration: 10 hours*



2. CASTLES AND UNESCO CAVES OF THE GEMER REGION

Explore the Gemer region, a landscape interwoven with old legends. Experience its rich mining tradition, the history of famous ruling families and forget your earthly life for a while in the underground kingdom of caves. Krásna Hôrka, one of the few preserved castles in Slovakia, stands on a stony hill not far from the town of Rožňava. A tour of the castle will lead you through dozens of chambers where you can admire historic photographs and furniture, weapons and false coins. The tour ends in a chapel with the mummified remains of the Duchess Zsofia Serédy. The trip continues to the chateau in Betliar, a family hunting lodge of the aristocratic Adrássy noble family. Learn about the life of the family and enjoy their original furnishings, precious library and rich collections, including a four-thousand-year-old Egyptian mummy. After the tour you can walk around and relax in one of the most beautiful English-style parks in Slovakia.

Now comes the time to explore the underground world of caves in the national park Slovenský kras. In **Domica** cave you can take a subterranean boat trip under a stalactite arch. The unique aragonite cave **Ochtinská aragonitová jaskyňa** will surprise you with a sky full of stars made of white crystal aragonite. If you like adventure, the cave **Krásnohorská jaskyňa** is the perfect place for you. In full speleologist's equipment you will reach one of the biggest stalactites in the world.

Trip duration: 10 hours



3. UNIQUE TOKAJ WINE CELLARS AND VINEYARDS

Tokaj wine – this delicious aromatic gold-coloured dessert wine was enjoyed already in the 17th century by Louis XIV at his royal court. It was first made by **Sepsi Laczko Maté** in 1650. We invite you to wine tasting directly in a medieval wine cellar in the world's acclaimed winemaking region of Tokaj. You will learn about the history of winemaking, the technology of Tokaj wine production and, what's more important, taste a wide assortment of unforgettable wines. Besides, you can also enjoy local specialities of the Zemplín region and Slovak or Hungarian cuisine.

Trip duration: 5 hours



4. SLOVENSKÝ RAJ NATIONAL PARK

The national park Slovenský raj has been included among **the most beautiful national parks of Central Europe** thanks to its unique natural beauty. The trip will take you to **deep ravines with waterfalls**, you will walk on a vast plateaux and see unforgettable karst phenomena. Besides magnificent nature, you will visit the historic **medieval town of Levoča** the gateway to the park, and you can end your active day by relaxing in **the thermal swimming pool Vrbov**.

Trip duration: 12 hours



5. PIENINY NATIONAL PARK

A trip to the nostalgic part of north-east Slovakia, where you will travel back in time. You will be enchanted by the surrounding nature's beauty where several historic films have been shot, as well as by a visit to the ancient monastery Červený kláštor, where the legendary "flying" Cyprian monk lived and where monks ran a much sought-after pharmacy since as early as the mid-18th century. After a walk in the surroundings of the monastery, you will start your adrenaline-packed rafting on the River Dunajec (a river border shared with Poland) through a breathtaking rocky canyon, seated in traditional rafts. From the border of Slovakia and Poland, the trip continues on to take you to the town of Stará Ľubovňa, into the region best known for two attractions – the castle Ľubovniansky hrad and the traditional shepherd-style restaurant Salaš u Franka. You can savour both during the trip. After a hard day, a few relaxing moments in the natural thermal swimming pool Vrbov will round things off just nice.

Trip duration: 12 hours



6. UNCESCO WOODEN CHURCHES AND FOLK ART

Ladomírová, Bodružal, Hervartov, Ruská Bystrá – all four villages in the north-east of Slovakia have one unique thing in common. They are home to four of the eight impressive wooden churches situated in the Slovak part of the Carpathian mountain arch, all of which have been registered in the UNESCO World Heritage List. You can admire them also from inside. Besides a tour of wooden churches, the trip will take you also to another UNESCO heritage site – the town of Bardejov, known thanks to its Gothic square and fortifications. The folk art and life of a traditional Slovak village is presented in the nearby open-air folk architecture museum – Múzeum ľudovej architektúry within the grounds of Bardejovské kúpele (Bardejov Spa).

WEEKEND TIPS - Be inspired

Has Košice captured your interest? Have you decided to spend a weekend but are not sure how to plan it? Here are a few ideas on how to plan your visit so that you see as much as possible and have most fun. Be inspired by the programme prepared for you by the Košice Visitor Centre.

A FAMILY WEEKEND IN THE SUMMER

Day one: After arriving in Košice and checking-in, there is no point losing time. Head straight to the city centre for a city sightseeing tour. For children with families we recommend the Most beautiful Gems of Košice (see page 8). Have your dinner at one of the family-friendly restaurants (page 35). Then you can have an ice-cream cup on a café terrace and wander the main street till sunset.

Day two: After a rich breakfast, we recommend a ride by Children's railway from Čermel' to Alpínka (page 37), the Tarzania high rope park, golf and a train ride back. Stop for lunch in the nearby restaurant Baránok, which is on the way. Then go to Kavečany and walk around the Košice Castle, where you can climb up to the Vyhliadková veža (Watchtower, page ...). Do not miss a visit to Košice Zoo (page 36) while in Kavečany, and don't forget to bring carrots and apples – the small goats are always hungry. Finish your day by an adrenaline toboggan ride (page 36) jumping on a trampoline and an excellent dinner. If you have bigger children, you can take them to the cinema. We recommend starting day three by visiting the historical prison Miklušova väznica (Mikluš Prison) and the executioner's house Katov byt (Executioner's Flat, page 19). Before lunch, you will still have time for the Slovak Technical Museum – the Chamber of electric charge (page 20). Afternoon is the time for doing sports. Come to lake Jazero and try waterskiing (page 41).

A SPECIAL TIP: Stay one more day and set out for a trip to the surroundings of Košice. Children might enjoy the tour Castles and UNESCO caves of the Gemer region (page 58), or the Pieniny National Park (page 59).

WINTER WEEKEND FOR THE FAMILY

When visiting with your family during winter - replace the second day with a trip to the surroundings of Košice to the Castles and UNESCO caves of the Gemer region (page 58), and spend the afternoon of the third day in the Botanical Gardens (page 36), at Košice Zoo (page 36) or the Planetarium (page 20).

AN ACTIVE WEEKEND

Day one: Arrival in Košice, a thematic sightseeing tour of the city "The most beautiful gems of Košice", and climbing the tower of St. Elisabeth's Cathedral (page 8), a concert / sports match in STEEL ARENA (page 40), in the evening and a spa (page 42).

Day two: A trip to the Castles and UNESCO caves of the Gemer region (page 58) in its adrenaline version – entry to the cave Krásnohorská jaskyňa in speleologist's equipment. An evening spent as recommended in A great night out (page 52).

Day three: Skiing/ tennis/ swimming in the indoor swimming pool in the morning (pages 40 and 41), lupph in a great restaurant (page 45), waterskiing (page 41) /hot air balloon flight above Košice (page 38), / parachuting in the afternoon (page 41).

PACKAGE-TOUR WEEKEND / WEEKEND For Seniors

Day one: Arrival in Košice, accommodation check-in and transfer to the Košice Visitor Centre, where the thematic sightseeing "Old Town Walk" begins (page 11). A dinner in one of the top restaurants (page 45), a concert of the State Philharmonic Orchestra / a performance in the State Theatre (page 28). We recommend a glass of wine or the special cocktail drink Košice Gold (page 52) after the performance.

Day two: A morning walk in Bankov (page 37) or a visit to the Botanical Gardens (page 36), an afternoon trip to the Tokaj region – unique wine cellars (page 59). Return back to Košice in the evening and relax in the spa with a massage (page 42).

Day three: Morning thematic sightseeing "Jewish Košice" (page 15) or "Religious Košice" (page 13), a culinary lunch (page 45), a coffee or dessert in a café (page 48). An afternoon visit to the Slovak Technical Museum (page 20), the East Slovak Gallery and the Vojtech Löffler Museum (page 28).

SPECIAL TIP Stay one more day and set out on a trip to the surroundings of Košice. UNESCO Monuments of the Spis region (page 58), or Wooden Churches and Folk Arts (nane 60) are ideal tips.



GETTING AROUND KOŠICE



By car / Parking

Driving a car in Košice is simple. If you just need to pass through, there are two circuits. The historic city centre is a pedestrian zone and car access is allowed only according to special rules. Please pay attention to one-way roads close to the centre. Parking in the city centre (in designated parking zones) is charged – in streets as well as attended parking lots. You can tell a paid parking space by the blue vertical signs showing a parking meter. The fee is 1€/hour or 8€/day. You can pay at a parking machine, which will give you a receipt, or you can buy a half-hour or hour parking card at sales points. Place them in a visible place in your car. You can pay for parking also by sending an SMS message in the form "KE (space) name of the parking zone (space) registration number of the parked vehicle" to the telephone number 2200 (a return text message will confirm that you have paid for one hour of parking). The parking fee is payable on Mondays – Fridays from 7.30 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on Saturdays from 7.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. At other times of the day, on Sundays and holidays, parking in the city centre is free of charge. Fees are not paid all week by people with severe physical handicap and those over 70. You can make use of three hours free parking at the shopping centre OC Aupark on the square Námestie osloboditeľov.

Public transport

Trams, trolleybuses or buses will take you to places more distant from the city centre. You can buy tickets (no-transfer ticket for four stops, transfer ticket for 30 or 60 minutes, 60-minute night ticket. 24-hour or 7-day ticket). They are available at newsagents, ticket machines or from the driver for € 1. A 60-minute ride can also be paid by sending an SMS message to 1166 (only Slovak mobile operators), and the ticket and price have to be confirmed by a return message before getting on. From May 2013 you can make use of free travel by buying the city discount card Košice Welcome Card.
