DAY 1
WELCOME TO BRATISLAVA – BEAUTY ON THE DANUBE RIVER

Welcome drink and itinerary introduction. Your lovely holiday starts today.

<u>Book with us an airport pick up service</u> from Bratislava, Vienna, Prague, Budapest and get the best possible price, travel in style with the highest comfort.

How do we provide this service? We will wait for you at the airport's arrival hall holding a sign with your name, help you with your luggage, drive you safely and comfortably to Bratislava and help with the check in. Maximum comfort, mineral water on board and a pleasant drive.

Morning – We'll drive to Devin Castle (15min drive) - situated at the confluence of the Danube & Morava rivers. Its owners could control the important trade route along the Danube as well as one branch of the Amber Road. After admiring the beautiful castle ruin and enjoying views on Austria, we show you where once the "Iron curtain" – the former border between the West and the East used to stand. An overview of the communist history (1948-1989). Devin area is also famous for its currant wine. Have you ever tried it? Try now, It's a regional specialty. On the way back to Bratislava's old town, we'll visit Slavin World War2 memorial and Bratislava Castle, - symbol of the city. Enjoy stunning views of the Danube river and know more about its rich history.

Afternoon - After lunch break, we'll continue with the Quality Sightseeing Walking Tour to see the highlights of the Old town. We'll start on a Hviezdoslav square, a prominent 18th century square surrounded by stunning palaces, the Slovak National Theatre and the Slovak Philharmonic Orchestra. Visit of the St. Martin's Cathedral - the coronation place of 18 rulers including famous Austria-Hungarian empress Maria Theresa, we stroll on medieval streets such as Panska and Venturska where famous music composers studied or gave concerts, such as W.A.Mozart, F. Liszt, L. Beethoven. Admire the only preserved town entrance – St. Michael's Gate. Walking through the main square, admire a beautiful former Old Town Hall and Maximilian Fountain, the Primate's Palace (outside) - the largest in Bratislava where the Treaty of Pressburg was signed in the Hall of Mirrors. Enough time for taking pictures and enjoying the atmosphere.

You'll get tips which museum and gallery is worth to see, where to enjoy coffee & cake, a glass of excellent Slovak wine, where to buy good quality souvenirs. Your quide is ready to help you.

DAY 2 BANSKA STIAVNICA and VLKOLINEC / UNESCO World Heritage

Morning – A scenic drive east. After 2hrs of driving we'll be in one of the most beautiful and most romantic - a picturesque Banska Stiavnica. It is like to step in the past centuries. Get an overview of the rich history of this town connected with the mining of copper, silver and gold. Visit the Old castle – a majestic fortress, 16th century New castle and the heart of the Old town – the Holy Trinity square with beautiful sights such as the gothic 15th century St. Catherine church, admire Renaissance buildings and the baroque Holy Trinity column.

<u>Afternoon</u> - Lunch break at restaurant Monarchia is about home-made specialties and great atmosphere. Do you like beer? Then, ERB restaurant will satisfy you with its high-quality microbrewery and a delicious cuisine.

Which of these special beers from Slovak ingredients will be your favorite? Will it be Erb Pale lager 10 or 12, Erb Weizen 12, Erb Dark special 13 with balanced bitter and sweet tastes? Free time for souvenirs, coffee & cake break.

We'll continue to see a unique, 18th century articular wooden church **Hronsek**, then, we'll drive to an exceptional mountain village **Vlkolinec** (UNESCO sight since 1993), hidden in hills of National Park Velka Fatra. Enjoy breathtaking panorama views and colorful 45 wooden log houses. It is the best-preserved oasis of folk architecture. We continue to High Tatra mountains – the heart of Slovakia.

Evening - Dinner on your own or we can book the tables at Koliba restaurant – a traditional wooden chalet with traditional tasty Slovak dishes, waiters in folk costumes and Slovak folk music. Start with a shot of "Slivovica" – a plum brandy. Garlic soup, cabbage or lentil soup? Enjoy our national meal Bryndzove halusky (Potato dumplings with melted sheep cheese and pieces of bacon). What about dessert? Apple strudel is highly recommended to try.

Overnight in High Tatras / Strbske pleso or Stary Smokovec or Tatranska Lomnica

DAY 3 THE HIGH TATRA MOUNTAINS – THE HEART OF SLOVAKIA

Morning - It's easy to fall in love with High Tatras - mountains with its picturesque valleys, brooks, waterfalls, colorful meadows, tarns with crystal clear water. We are very excited to show you our lovely mountains, firstly, drive to Stary Smokovec town to take a funicular railway (tickets not included) to get Hrebienok and walk to the waterfalls. An easy walking tour in the nature.

<u>Afternoon</u> - We move to Tatranska Lomnica town (15min by car) to take a cable car (tickets not included) to Skalnate pleso station to see the High Tatra mountains from above. We enjoy a little walk around Skalnate pleso, views of the Lomnicky peak and valley views.

Please note, if you would like to go up to the top of Lomnicky peak (2nd highest peak in High Tatras), it is necessary an advance booking with a full payment for the tickets in advance. Please let us know.

Other possibilities what to do today (in case of bad weather or you do not like cable cars)

- 1, easy walking tour to Popradske pleso lake (on the smooth road, total of 2-3 hours of walking)
- 2, longer hiking tour, total of 6-7 hours (e.g. up to cottage by Green lake or Teryho cottage)
- 3, visit the only accessible cave in High Tatras Belianska cave (tickets not included)
- 4, museum about the National park of High Tatras (tickets not included)
- 5, Aquapark Poprad swimming, saunas, SPA treatments (tickets not included)

Evening - On your own

Overnight in High Tatras / Strbske pleso or Stary Smokovec or Tatranska Lomnica

DAY 4 LEVOCA and SPISS CASTLE / UNESCO

<u>Morning</u> – We'll travel further to the east to visit the **Spiss Castle** (45min drive). It is not just an evidence of architectural development from the 12th to 18th century, but it is one of the largest castle ruins in Central Europe. Mighty and impressive fortress in a stunning location. Get more information about the former owners - famous dynasties such as Zapolsky, Thurzo and Csaky. Visit the castle kitchen, chapel, torture chamber and enjoy the views from the upper terraces.

<u>Afternoon</u> - History enthusiasts will admire charming medieval town <u>Levoca</u>, cultural & historic jewel among Slovak towns. Visit of the 14th century Roman Catholic basilica of St. James with its tallest wooden wing gothic altar in the world - a masterpiece from Master Paul of Levoca. Get more details about this amazing wood crafter in a museum where he lived and worked.

Lunch break and comfortable drive to Bratislava via the northern way, enjoy spectacular views of the Slovak longest river Vah, several castle ruins such as Strecno, Beckov, winding roads and green scenery. Back to Bratislava and at leisure.
