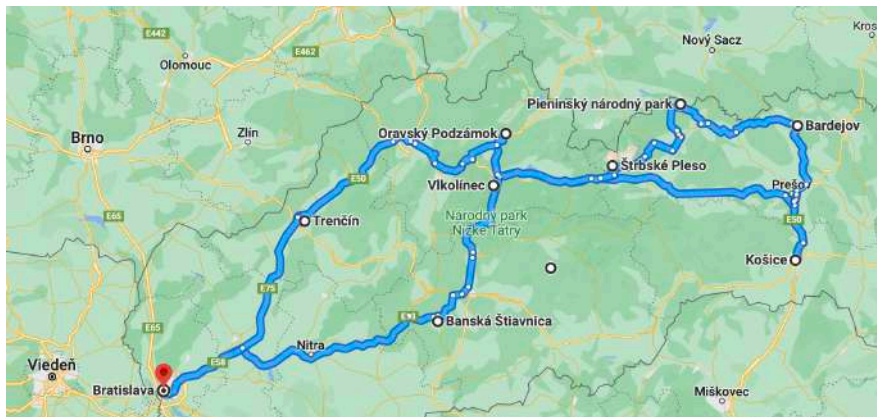

DAY 1

WELCOME TO BRATISLAVA – BEAUTY ON THE DANUBE RIVER

Welcome drink and itinerary introduction. Your lovely holiday starts today.

DAY 2

BRATISLAVA QUALITY SIGHTSEEING TOUR

We'll drive to Devin Castle, situated at the confluence of the Danube & Morava rivers. Its owners could control the important trade route along the Danube as well as one branch of the Amber Road. After exploring the well-preserved castle ruins and enjoying views of Austria, we'll show you where the "Iron Curtain" – the former border between the West and the East used to stand and tell the story of life under communism (1948-89). On the way back to Bratislava's old town, we'll visit Slavin World War2 memorial and Bratislava Castle, - symbol of the city. Enjoy stunning views of the Danube river and learn more about its rich history.

After lunch break, we'll continue with a charming city walking tour to see the highlights of the Old Town. We start at Hviezdoslav square, a prominent 18th century square surrounded by stunning palaces, the Slovak National Theatre and the Slovak Philharmonic Orchestra, visit the St. Martin's Cathedral - the coronation place of 18 rulers, including famous Austria-Hungarian empress Maria Theresa; we stroll on medieval streets such as Panska and Venturska where famous music composers studied or gave concerts, such as W. A. Mozart, F. Liszt, L. Beethoven, and admire the only preserved town entrance – St. Michael's Gate. Walking through the main square, admire the beautiful former Old Town Hall and Maximilian Fountain, the Primate's Palace (outside) - the largest in Bratislava. Enough free time for taking pictures and enjoying the atmosphere.

Welcome dinner & wine tasting at Peter & Jane's house.

Overnight in Bratislava

Total driving distance: 70km/43mi, total driving time: 1hrs 15min, walking: 2miles

DAY 3

DISCOVER PICTURESQUE BANSKA STIAVNICA

After 2 hours of scenic drive crossing the rolling Danube plains, we'll enter one of the most beautiful Slovak towns – **Banska Stiavnica**. It is like stepping into past centuries. Get an overview of the rich history of this town connected with the mining of copper, silver and gold. Visit the Old castle – a majestic fortress, 16th century New castle, the heart of the Old town and Holy Trinity square with beautiful sights such as the gothic 15th century St. Catherine church, admire renaissance buildings and the baroque Holy Trinity column. Tasty lunch break at the restaurant Monarchia (home-made specialties) or enjoy lunch and famous beer at the restaurant ERB (microbrewery and fine dining). A short stop to see a hidden jewel, the wooden articular church **Hronsek**, listed on UNESCO World Heritage). We'll continue to **Banska Bystrica** – the 6th largest Slovak city and geographical centre of Slovakia. A short introduction tour around the main square to see the highlights. There is a saying "while alive in Banska Bystrica, after death in heaven".

Overnight in Banska Bystrica

Total driving distance: 225km/139mi, total driving time: 2hrs 30min, walking: 1mile

DAY 4

ADMIRE 3 UNESCO JEWELS - VLKOLINEC, MEDIEVAL LEVOCA & SPISS CASTLE

Visit the Museum of the Slovak National Uprising (open-air museum and a permanent exhibition of WW2), then we'll drive to **Vlkolinec** mountain village (UNESCO), famous for its colourful wooden houses. Go back in time and see how people used to live two centuries ago. Enjoy the stunning views of the National Park Velka Fatra.

Lunch break in a charming medieval town **Levoca**. It is undoubtedly a cultural and historical jewel among Slovak towns. Enter the Roman-Catholic church of St. James from the 14th century with its tallest wooden wing gothic altar in the world, a masterpiece by Master Paul of Levoca.

On our way to **Kosice** we'll admire the mighty **Spiss Castle**, built on a dolomite rock. It is one of the largest castle ruins in Central Europe. Drive through **Spisska Kapitula**, also known as "Slovak Vatikan" (outside). Continue to Kosice.

Overnight in Kosice

Total driving distance: 250km/155mi, total driving time: 3hrs 15min, walking: 1-2miles

DAY 5,

EXPERIENCE KOSICE CITY - CULTURAL CAPITAL OF 2013

We'll bring you the rich history of **Kosice** to life on our quality sightseeing walking tour around the spectacular Old Town. Enter St. Elizabeth's Cathedral, considered to be one of the most beautiful gothic structures in the world, admire St. Michael's Chapel, the State Theatre, the St. Urbain's Tower and visit the Lane of Arts and Crafts. Relax in a park with the famous singing fountain. Enjoy a free afternoon.

Optional trips:

1, Easy walking tour in Zadiel gorge, price: EUR 55 per person

2, Wine tasting in Tokaj wine region (1hr 15min drive), tasty dinner (roasted duck, dumplings, red cabbage) followed by the wine tasting of 10 different wines, price: EUR 85 per person

Overnight in Kosice

DAY 6

KOSICE > HERVARTOV WOODEN CHURCH & BARDEJOV

Time to discover the fabulous Saris region, we'll drive to the village **Hervartov** to see the unique wooden Roman-Catholic church of St. Francis of Assisi from the 15th century.

Then, drive to one of the most beautiful medieval towns - **Bardejov**, settled in the 14th century, fortified with stone walls and bastions to repel foreign tribes. Most of the walls and bastions are still standing.

Our exploration we start with **Bardejov Spa** - trying the healing water. It was a place where prominent European rulers and personalities spent some time, among the most famous belong the empress Elisabeth, known as Sissi. Try the healing water from eight springs; Main, Medical,

Claire, Elisabeth, Napoleon, Francis, Hercules and Alexander. Next to the Spa resort there is the oldest open-air museum in Slovakia. Let's go back to the life of the 19th-20th century of the Slovaks and Rusyns. Walk into the houses of peasants, middle class, mayor's house, then we'll come back to Bardejov for the walking tour.

Quality sightseeing tour in the heart of Bardejov town to see the highlights - Town Hall's square, gothic St. Egidius church, climb the church tower with its fantastic view of the former fortification walls around the city.

Optional visits: Museum of History of Bardejov, Museum of Icons, Jewish Suburbia visit

Overnight in Bardejov

Total driving distance: 95km/59mi, total driving time: 1hrs 30min, walking: 1 -2miles

DAY 7, JOURNEY TO PIENINY NATIONAL PARK

Today, we'll discover the **Pieniny National Park** and do calm-water rafting on wooden boats* It is an incredibly charming, green area where the river Dunajec creates a natural border between Poland and Slovakia. The ride takes 1 hour 15min on a calm river. Lunch in the Goral region, trying Goral meals and drinks. Stop in the former Red Monastery where two different types of monks used to live. *) The alternative program is a walking tour to 3 Crown hill.

Overnight in Strbske Pleso

Total driving distance: 160km/99mi, total driving time: 2hrs 30min, walking: 1-2miles

DAY 8, UNCOVER THE BEAUTY OF OUR HIGH TATRA MOUNTAINS

It's easy to fall in love with the High Tatras - mountains with its picturesque valleys, brooks, waterfalls, colorful meadows, tarns with crystal clear water.

We are excited to show you our lovely mountains. We'll to drive to **Stary Smokovec** to take a funicular railway (tickets not included) to get to Hrebienok and walk to the waterfalls. An easy, enjoyable walking tour in the nature. Then, we'll travel to **Tatranska Lomnica** (15min by car) to take a cable car (tickets not included) to Skalnaté pleso station to see the High Tatra mountains from above. We'll enjoy a little walk at the top with views of the Lomnický peak and the expansive valley plains below.

Alternatives:

- 1, easy walking tour to Popradské pleso lake (on the smooth road, total of 2-3 hours of walking)
- 2, longer hiking tour, total of 6-7 hours (e.g. up to cottage by Green lake or Téryho cottage)
- 3, visit the only accessible cave in High Tatras – the Belianska cave (tickets not included)

Overnight in Strbske Pleso

Total driving distance: 45km/27mi, total driving time: 1hr 15min, walking: 1-2miles

DAY 9

SPECTACULAR ORAVA REGION

We'll discover another wonderful region of Slovakia – the **Orava region**. A visit of open-air Museum of Orava village will give you a picture of how people used to live in the past. It is a wonderfully located "skanzen" in the western part of the Tatra mountains.

We'll continue to visit the famous, mighty fortress – the Orava castle, situated high on the rock above the river Orava. It definitely belongs to one of the greatest attractions of northern Slovakia. Get an interesting history overview, myths and legends.

Drive to **Trencin**. Enjoy a short walking tour around the recently reconstructed city centre and the Trencin castle situated right above the Old town.

Overnight in Trencin

Total driving distance: 280km/173mi, total driving time: 3hrs 45min, walking: 1-2miles

DAY 10,

FAIRY-TALE CICMANY VILLAGE and BOJNICE CHATEAU

Driving back to Bratislava through scenic countryside with a stop in a fairy-tale **Cicmany village**, famous for wooden houses painted with white ornaments. We'll continue to **Bojnice** town to admire the most romantic **Chateau Bojnice**, rated in 2017 as one of the 10 most beautiful castles in the world according to the National Geographic magazine. Tour through the fully furnished rooms, the Golden Hall, the Chapel, the Grand Hall, the Blue and Green saloon. Which room is your favorite? Enjoy a relaxing evening in Bratislava.

Overnight in Bratislava

Total driving distance: 260km/161mi, total driving time: 3hrs 45min, walking: 1-2miles
